THE STORY :

Drs. Abby Yates (Melissa McCarthy) and Erin Gilbert (Kristen Wiig) are co-authors of a book which posits the existence of paranormal phenomena such as ghosts. OUR REVIEW :

Variety and The Hollywood Reporter reported in August 2014 that Paul Feig had been selected as director and that the reboot would feature an all-female cast. A third Ghostbusters film had been in various stages of development following the release of Ghostbusters II in 1989. Sony decided to reboot the series with much of the original film's cast in cameo roles. The female cast was announced in 2015.
